- To enroll in classes, I must submit to The Graduate College: **1)** an online, non-degree-seeking application and fee, **2)** one official transcript from the institution granting my highest degree (uploaded transcripts will not meet this requirement), and **3)** this completed Non-Degree-Seeking Student Form to my online application, including all department-provided approvals.
- As courses must be approved on a semester-by-semester basis, I must complete a new Non-Degree-Seeking Student Form for each semester I intend to study as a non-degree-seeking student. For subsequent semesters, the updated form should be submitted by email to gradcollege@txstate.edu.
- I understand that admission as a non-degree-seeking student does not constitute admission to a master’s or doctoral degree program at Texas State, nor does it imply that satisfactory work will guarantee admission to a degree-granting program. (Courses taken will be shown as “post-baccalaureate” credit on your Texas State transcript. If you are admitted to a degree program, up to six hours of graduate-level courses completed with a grade of “B” or better may be petitioned for degree credit.)
- I understand that, if I am classified as a non-U.S. citizen or non-U.S. permanent resident, I must fulfill the non-degree-seeking student admission requirements outlined for international students.
